

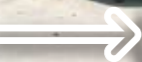

introduction

The Lane Cove Bus Interchange enables bus users and residents of the region access to better transport alternatives and bus to bus connections.

Accessing public transport has been made easier by closely linking the buses with an overhead pedestrian bridge over Epping Rd, making it safer and easier for customers to make their connections.

You can catch one of the many buses departing Lane Cove Bus Interchange to most parts of western and northern Sydney. Services depart frequently and many operate from early morning until late at night.

This guide gives a general description of bus services using the interchange as well as general information about the facilities available.

Bus Service Access

Access to buses is located on both sides of Longueville Rd and consolidates all bus services to one location easily accessible using the new overhead bridge above Longueville Rd.

The interchange features large passenger information displays, high level lighting, bus shelters and comfortable seating.

Buses depart from two dedicated city bound bus stands. See the map shown below for the location of the various facilities in the interchange area. There are also bus stands and shelters located for services heading out of the City on Longueville Rd and Phoenix St.

Bus tickets While tickets may be purchased on

board many bus services, Sydney Buses encourages passengers to purchase tickets in advance, saving you and other passengers unnecessary delays. Pre-paid tickets are available at most newsagents and convenience stores. For Hillsbus services, single tickets can be purchased on board (TravelTen, Travelpass and other pre-pay tickets not valid on these services).
